EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLANNING

SCOPE

This guideline shall apply to all members of the Stoney Point Fire Department and shall be adhered to by all members.

To establish procedures for all Stoney Point Fire Department members who respond and operate under and in accordance with Cumberland County's and the City of Fayetteville Emergency Operation Plan.
