



NON-SPRINKLERED STRUCTURE

SCOPE

This guideline shall apply to all members of the Stoney Point Fire Department and shall be adhered to by all members.

PURPOSE

To assist Incident Commanders in the management of fire ground incidents at non-sprinklered structures.

DEFINITIONS

Guideline - a general rule, principle, outline of a policy

Member – any career, volunteer, staff, and auxiliary personnel affiliated with the department

Shall - indicates a mandatory requirement

GUIDELINES

While enroute to the emergency, query Dispatch about the location and extent of the fire within the structure. Upon arrival at the scene, conduct a scene size up, including strategic priorities of rescue, fire control, and property conservation. Confer with occupants on scene to determine type of fire, location, and any life hazards. Ensure that an evacuation has been started and is proceeding. Typical tasks to be accomplished at non-sprinklered structures include:

Attack Engine

- Conduct scene size up and establish command
- Establish water supply (hydrant, static sources, pumper/tanker hook up or water shuttle/drop tank operation)
- Deploy attack line(s) to the area of the fire and conduct aggressive fire attack
- Conduct primary search of the area in vicinity of the fire
- After knockdown is achieved begin salvage and overhaul operations
- Perform other assignments as directed by the Incident Commander

Second Due Engine

- Establish water supply to the attack Engine as directed by the Incident Commander
- Deploy back-up attack line(s) from attack Engine to support for initial attack line
- Assist with ventilation requirements needed
- Conduct secondary search
- Perform other assignments as directed by the Incident Commander

Service Unit

- Establish manpower if not already established
- Establish equipment pools and forward available personnel to manpower
- Establish support functions (air supply, rehab, etc.)
- Perform other assignments as directed by the Incident Commander

Third Due Apparatus and Tankers

- Assist with water supply if needed
- Position vehicle in area for availability
- Forward personnel to manpower pool for assignment
- Perform other assignments as directed by the Incident Commander
